Hop-On Hop-Off Historic Columbia River Highway Trolley

Hourly Daily Departures from 9 AM



Want to avoid the traffic and parking problems on the Historic Columbia River Highway? Want to take a hike on one of the trails but uncertain about parking. Want to marvel at the sights and not miss the history and geography behind them? Enjoy your trip on the Historic Highway instead of worrying about the traffic, the road and parking. Hop on our narrated Historic Columbia River Highway Trolley (Waterfall Trolley) for an experience you will not forget on the world famous waterfall corridor. Hop on or hop off at one of the nine stops for some sightseeing or a hike. Stops are made at Corbett, Crown Point, Latourell Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, Angels Rest, Wahkeena Falls, Multnomah Falls, Triple Falls, Horsetail Falls and Ainsworth State Park. We do not stop at non-designated sites.

Our open-air trolleys feature unobstructed sightseeing and photo taking. The trolleys are sanitized after each trip for your protection.

If you are driving, you may join this tour in Corbett on the Historic Highway with ample free parking available. If you arrive by scheduled bus service from the Portland area, you may join the tour at Multnomah Falls.

Departs from Corbett starting at 9:00am. Departures from Multnomah Falls Lodge begin at 9:33 heading east and 10:00am heading west.

Service is once per hour or more frequently if demand warrants.

A current schedule will be available at the ticket locations, on the trolleys and on line at www.waterfalltrolley.com.

If you do not get off, the round trip on the trolley takes 90 minutes from Corbett or 120 minutes from Multnomah Falls.

Join our tour coach for your ride out to Multnomah Falls where you will board the Waterfall Trolley as early as 9:30 to begin your tour of the waterfall corridor and the opportunity to spend the full day in the gorge enjoying the numerous viewing and hiking options. The Hop-on hop-off Waterfall Trolley provides an all-day experience on the full 13-mile waterfall corridor. Enjoy a coach ride back to Portland, leaving Corbett at 3:00 pm.

OUR SALES AND BOARDING LOCATIONS: In Portland we board guests at one centralized location at the Benson Hotel. Starting 45 minutes before the departure time the boarding staff will be inside the Benson at a Gray Line service desk. 15 minutes prior to departure the staff will be at our loading area on the north side of the hotel at 710 SW Oak Street. There will be a Gray Line Loading Zone sidewalk sign at that location. The Benson is a short walk from most downtown hotels.

NOTE: The *Waterfall Trolley* departs from Corbett, OR, 25 miles east of Portland. The *Waterfall Express* departs from Portland and connects to the *Waterfall Trolley* at Multnomah Falls in the morning and at Corbett in the afternoon for the return to Portland.

Experience the Rose City's most renowned nature escape, the world famous Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area. This narrated half day tour showcases the incredible diversity of scenery at Portland's doorstep. We travel to Multnomah Falls along the river level route of the Lewis and Clark expedition and enjoy the unfolding panorama including Rooster Rock, Cape Horn, and Mist Falls, all sights first noted by the famous explorers over 200 years ago. You will have 30 minutes at the Falls to visit the viewpoint for photos, walk to the famous Benson footbridge at the base of the falls, and visit the historic landmark Multnomah Falls Lodge. The tour then continues to the Bonneville Dam, Fish Hatchery and fish ladders, a national historic site in the heart of the Gorge.

Then it is on to the Historic Columbia River Highway which features a portion of the world famous waterfall corridor, the "Latourell Loops" and Falls, and Sheppard's Dell. A 20 minute stop at Vista House situated on Crown Point is included.

On our return to Portland, you will again enjoy the unfolding panorama of views along the "River of the West," the Mighty Columbia.
