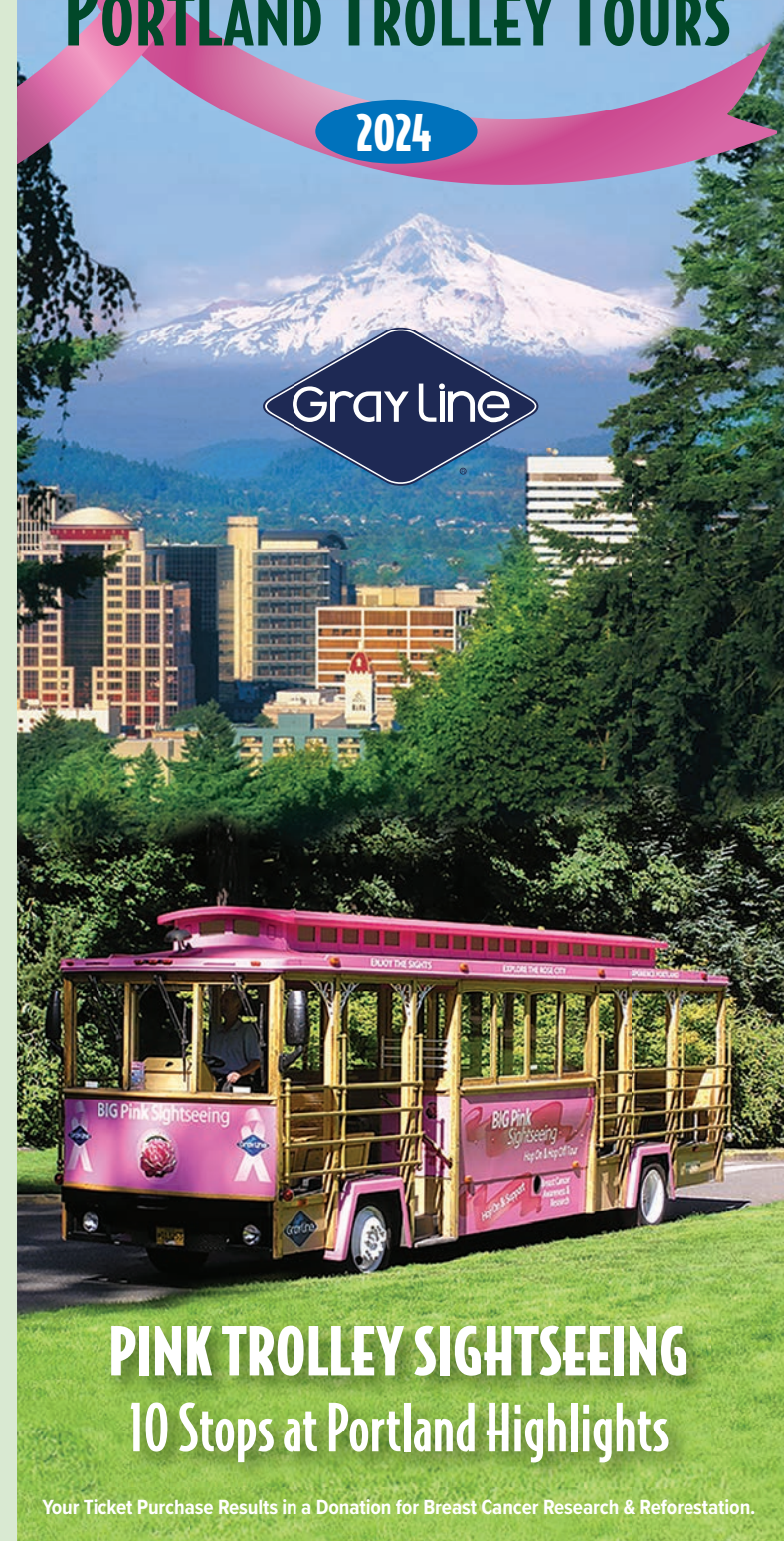

HOP-ON HOP-OFF TROLLEY TOUR

The Hop-on/Hop-off Pink Trolley Sightseeing Tour includes driver guide narration and 10 stops at the major attractions in Portland. With service at each stop every 60 minutes there is plenty of time during the day to see the Portland you want to see at the pace you choose. A full loop takes 55 minutes.

First departure from Stop 1 – Director Park at 846 SW Park Avenue is at 10:00 AM with the last departure leaving Stop 1 at 4:00 PM arriving back at Stop 1 at 4:55 PM. Buy your one-day or two-day pass from our trolley ticket booth at Stop 1 – Director Park or buy your ticket online and board at any stop.

DATES OF OPERATION: Dates of Operation: 5 days a week - Wednesdays thru Sundays, May 25 to September 15 – We do not operate on Mondays and Tuesdays. We do not operate on June 1 and 8 due to parades.

1 DIRECTOR PARK – Our departure point is in the center of downtown in Director Park which is kitty corner from the back of the Nordstrom store on Broadway. It is convenient to all downtown hotels, light rail and bus connections and the downtown shopping district. It is the perfect spot to begin your Portland adventure.

2 SOUTH PARK BLOCKS – Visit one of Portland's many parks and the heart of Portland's cultural district including the Performing Arts Center, Oregon Historical Society, and the Portland Art Museum.

3 ROSE AND JAPANESE GARDENS/WASHINGTON PARK – The Rose Garden is Portland's Post Card feature. Be sure to take a stroll through the four different gardens. In the Japanese Garden enjoy a sense of peace, harmony and tranquility that can come from touring the 5.5 acre garden that includes five distinctive garden styles. From this stop you may take advantage of the Washington Park Free Shuttle to the Zoo and World Forestry Center. The Shuttle operates every 15 minutes.

4 NW 23RD AVENUE SHOPPING DISTRICT – Portland's street of boutique shops and restaurants are sure to please your shopping instincts.

5 PEARL DISTRICT/POWELL'S BOOKS – Browse world-famous Powell's Books which lies in the heart of Portland's fashionable and fun Pearl District. Also enjoy the numerous shops and restaurants.

6 CHINESE GARDEN/OREGON CONVENTION CENTER VIA MAX – The Lan Su Chinese Garden, a Portland classic, is one of the most authentic Chinese gardens to be found anywhere. An oasis in the city. This stop also serves the Convention Center, Lloyd Center, and area hotels via MAX light rail service. (Tri-Met fare additional to Convention Center/Lloyd Center.)

7 WATERFRONT PARK – Across the street from the park, is a perfect jumping off point to Portland's many attractions. Convenient to all major downtown hotels, light rail, bus and the central shopping district. Nearby is Portland's famous Saturday Market.

8 RIVERPLACE – Portland's own riverfront village with shops, restaurants, the Esplanade, and a marina. Promenade with the locals!

9 CITY CENTER/PIIONEER PLACE – In the heart of downtown, two blocks from Portland's "Living Room," Pioneer Courthouse Square. Visit the Square for a sample of Portland's culture or visit the historic Federal Courthouse.

10 CITY CENTER NORTH – Convenient walking access to Portland's growing west end: restaurants, shops and hotels.
