



- PEARL DISTRICT/POWELL'S BOOKS Browse world-famous Powell's Books which lies in the heart of Portland's fashionable and fun Pearl District. Also enjoy the numerous shops and restaurants.
- CHINESE GARDEN/OREGON CONVENTION CENTER VIA MAX The Lan Su Chinese Garden, a Portland classic, is one of the most authentic Chinese gardens to be found anywhere. An oasis in the city.
