The *Gorge Explorer* provides four options for you to experience the Columbia River Gorge and world-famous Multnomah Falls. This national scenic area, the first designated scenic area in the country, has many natural highlights in addition to Multnomah Falls.

As you travel from Portland to your destination, you will see Rooster Rock, Cape Horn, The Pillars of Hercules and Crown Point among other sites from your large windows on our motorcoach. Narration enroute will add to your experience and enjoyment.

Upon arrival at Multnomah Falls and Lodge you can begin your adventure on one of the four options the Gorge Explorer offers.



Have just a morning or afternoon free? Take the 2.5-hour Multnomah Falls Express option for narrated tour and a one-hour visit to Multnomah Falls. With departures at 9:00 AM and 1:30 PM it fits in almost any schedule.

Have more time to spend? We have several options. The *Waterfall Express* option Includes a full day pass on the Hop-On Hop-Off Waterfall Trolley so you can visit the other waterfalls on the famous Waterfall Corridor. The Multnomah Falls for a Day Tour option transports you to and from Multnomah Falls to explore the area on you own.

Want to include a tour of Portland, try our *Multnomah Falls Express & Rose Garden Tour* which includes the one hour at Multnomah Falls and an afternoon pass on the *Rose City Trolley*. The best of both worlds for visitors that have a full day available.

REGARDING TOURS THAT INCLUDE MULTNOMAH FALLS

The Multnomah Falls & Waterfall Trolley (Waterfall Express – PDX07) and the Gorge Explorer (PDX08XX and PDX09) are coach tours that depart from Portland. The Gorge Explorer tour provides transportation from Portland via coach to Multnomah Falls in the morning with an afternoon transfer back to Portland. The Multnomah Falls & Waterfall Trolley (PDX07) tour provides transportation to and from the Waterfall Trolley boarding at Multnomah Falls. It includes a full day pass on the Waterfall Trolley.

With the ticket purchase of any of our tours that include travel to or a visit to Multnomah Falls you do not need a U.S. Forest Service reservation to visit and view Multnomah Falls or travel the Historic Highway on our trolleys or coaches.

Historic Columbia River Highway Trolley

Want to see more of the waterfalls and avoid the traffic and parking problems on the Historic Columbia River Highway? Want to take a hike on one of the trails but concerned about parking? Want to marvel at the sights and not miss the history and geography behind them? Enjoy your trip on the Historic Highway instead of worrying about the traffic, the road and parking. Hop-on our narrated Historic Columbia River Highway Trolley (Waterfall Trolley) for an experience you will not forget on the world-famous waterfall corridor. Hop-on or hop-off at one of the ten stops for some sightseeing or a hike. You can hop back on the next trolley. Stops are made at Corbett, Crown Point, Latourell Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, Angels Rest, Wahkeena Falls, Multnomah Falls, Triple Falls, Horsetail Falls and Ainsworth. Our open-air trolleys feature unobstructed sightseeing and photo taking.

Enjoy a coach ride back to Portland at 3:15 PM from Multnomah Falls to arrive in Portland before rush hour traffic. Price includes the coach transfer to and from the Waterfall Trolley, an all-day pass on the Waterfall Trolley and an all-day U.S. Forest Service reservation to visit and view Multnomah Falls.

Your ticket purchase includes the required pass to see Multnomah Falls.

En route, you will see the gateway to the Gorge and beautiful Columbia River, with views of both the Oregon and Washington side. Enjoy the onboard narration that enhances the experience.
